

First Robotics Challenge - Week 5

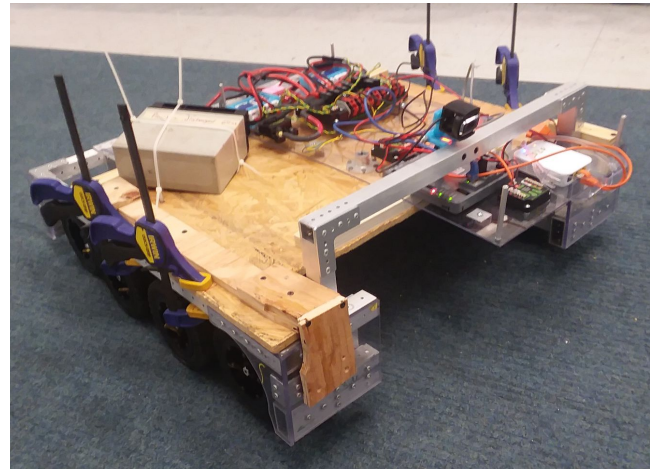


Woodie Flowers award nominee
